

Balloon Recipe

Birthday Dot Delight

Featuring a sparkly holographic balloon, this quick, air-filled design makes the perfect cash-and-carry offering. Just switch out the Microfoil for any milestone or general birthday message.

Estimated Cost: \$3

Labor: About 10 Minutes

Suggested Retail Price: \$15

Instructions:

1. Inflate two 11-inch Tropical Assortment latex to 6 inches and tie into a pair. Repeat to make a second pair. Wrap the two pairs together to make a four-balloon cluster. Tie the weight to the cluster.
2. Make a four-balloon cluster with 5-inch White latex inflated to 4 inches. Tie this cluster onto the previous cluster, rotating it so it nests.
3. Inflate the 12-inch Quick Link to 10 inches and tie the neck. Tie the Quick Link into the cluster from Step 2.
4. Make a four-balloon cluster with 5-inch White latex inflated to 3.5 inches. Tie this cluster onto the tip of the Quick Link.
5. Make a four-balloon cluster with 5-inch Tropical Assortment latex inflated to 4 inches. Tie this cluster into the cluster from Step 4, rotating it so it nests.
6. Air-inflate the 18-inch Microfoil. Roll up and tie the neck with a length of BalloonRibbon. Use the ribbon to tie the Microfoil tightly into the clusters at the top.



Materials:

- 1 18" "60 Big Dots & Glitz" Holographic Microfoil Balloon
- 1 12" Caribbean Blue Quick Link Balloon
- 4 11" Tropical Assortment Latex Balloons
- 8 5" White Latex Balloons
- 4 5" Tropical Assortment Latex Balloons
- Qualatex BalloonRibbon
- Small Sand Weight
